Traffic Accident and Power Interruption, 48th/Claire to Woodland

The Lincoln Police Department and our public service partners of the Public Works, Lincoln Electric System and Lincoln Fire & Rescue are currently working an active scene on 48th Street, Claire to Woodland.

On April 12, 2020 at approximately 12:08 PM, units were dispatched to just north of south 48th Street and Highway 2 on a car vs power pole accident. There is no information on injuries at this time. This accident has caused many houses and structures in the neighborhood to lose power.

LES crews are currently on scene working on restoring function to lights and power in the area, however the process will take an unknown amount of time. During these repairs the intersections of 48th and Claire and 48th and Woodland will need to be completely blocked to allow crews to safely work. We are asking for all who would normally use this route during this time to plan alternate routes until further notice.
