Marcus Remus Charged with Additional Robberies

On January 5, 2017, 19-year-old Marcus Remus, of Omaha, was arrested for the December 28th robbery at Union Bank and Trust, 6801 O Street. This arrest was the result of some outstanding forensic work, video analysis, and investigation by members of the Lincoln Police Department. Working collaboratively with the Omaha Police Department and the United States Marshal's Service, the firearm used in this robbery was later recovered.

On January 6, 2017, 26-year-old Shawn Brooks, of Lincoln, was arrested for his involvement in the same bank robbery. Both remain in custody at the Lancaster County Adult Detention Facility.

Since these arrests, our Criminal Investigations Unit has continued their excellent work. By working cooperatively with the Lancaster County Attorney's Office, Marcus Remus has been charged in three additional incidents:

- December 15, 2016 - Super C, 745 S. 21st Street, robbery and use of a weapon to commit a felony
- December 26, 2106 – U-Stop, 110 West O Street, robbery and use of a weapon to commit a felony
- December 30, 2016 - Roc's Stop & Shop, S. 27th and South Streets, attempted robbery and use of a weapon to commit a felony

We are continuing to piece together evidence and determine if Marcus Remus or Shawn Brooks are culpable for other robberies in Lincoln. At this time, Shawn Brooks has not been charged for additional crimes.

In addition to great work by a multitude of law enforcement agencies, these arrests would not have been possible without the partnerships of U-Stop, Super C, Roc's and Union Bank. All of these locations have invested in high quality video systems to help keep their employees safe, prevent crime, and assist law enforcement when offenses do occur. The employees who were present during these encounters have been through a lot and we are hopeful the arrests will bring some peace of mind.

The safety and security of Lincoln is not only the responsibility of those of us in law enforcement and the Lancaster County Attorney's Office, but citizens and business owners. U-Stop, Super C, Roc's Stop & Shop and Union Bank are great examples of businesses and employees in Lincoln who take ownership in this commitment.
