A Problem Solving Model

SCANNING: Officers identify problems by making on-site visits to observe activity and locations or talking to residents and other officers.

ANALYSIS: Officers learn everything about the actors, incidents and responses already tried to deal with the problem.

RESPONSE: Based on careful analysis, the officer develops a goal that can be reached using a custom-made response.

ASSESSMENT: Evaluating the effectiveness or extent that a program achieves its goals or produces desired results.
